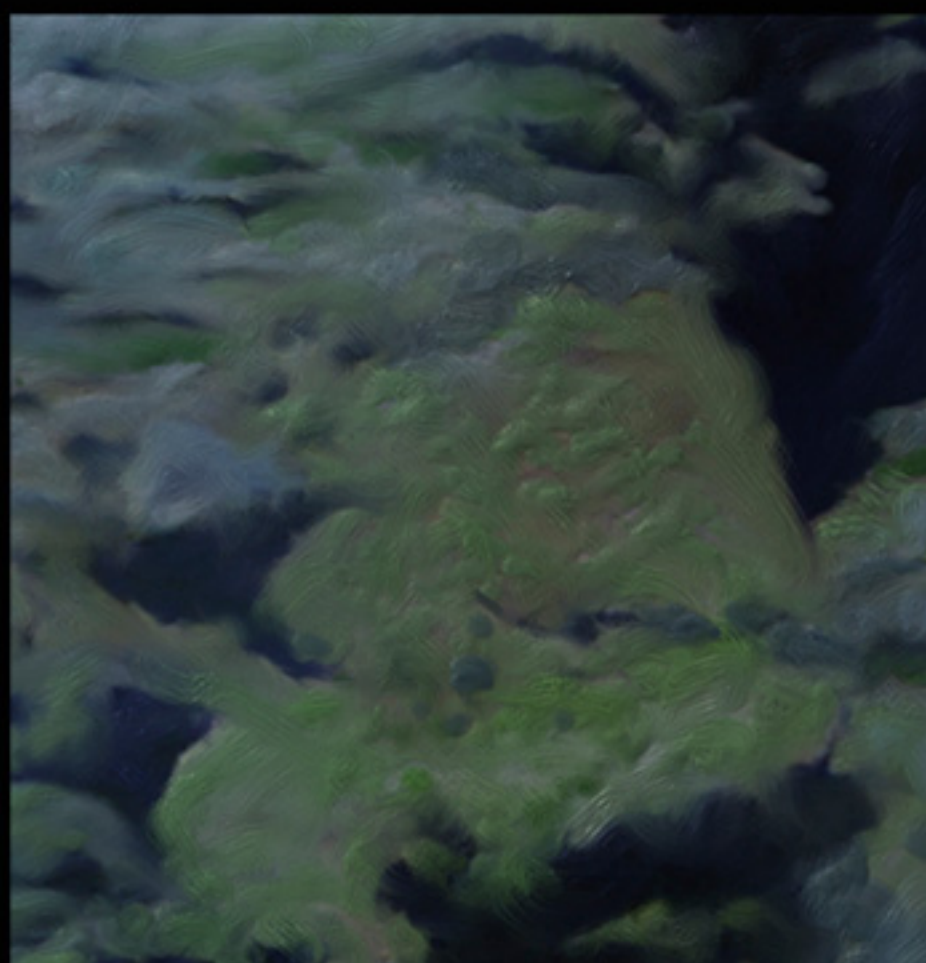

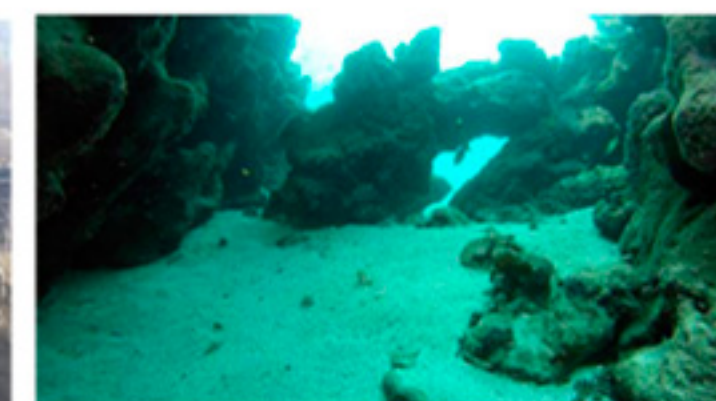

of brushwork.

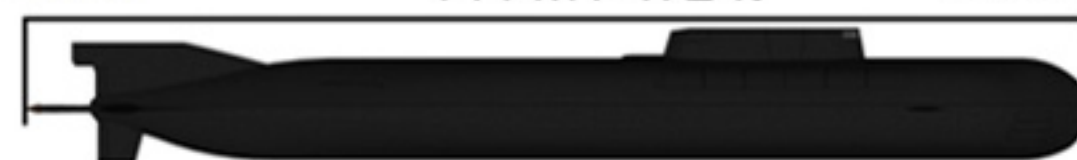
